

## High Security

The term **High Security** is commonly used to denote physical safety, protection of property and loss prevention.

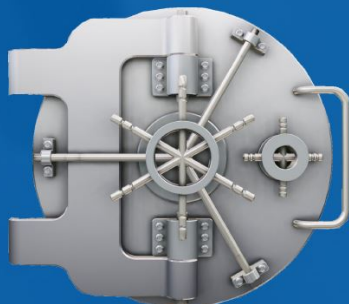
Security professionals during an audit and risk assessment will inspect the presence of the following components: Access Control, Physical Security and Key Management System.

**Access control** restricts entrance to unauthorized persons. If required, it can monitor record and limit access to authorized persons as well.

**Physical Security** restricts entrance by offering mechanical protection using commercial grade locks and high security cylinders. To protect against physical attacks, UL437 **CX5** high security cylinders have been successfully tested for picking, impression, forcing, drilling, sawing, prying, pulling, driving and corrosion.

**Key Management Systems** are required to manage the distribution of keys and their assignees. Patent protected key blanks prevent the unauthorized duplication of the keys. Elements of a good key management system include:

- Key control document
- Key control manager
- Key storage and record keeping facility
- Procedure for key assignment and requests, delivery and return
- Policy for non-returned keys
- Forms to facilitate policies and procedures
- Product servicing guidelines
